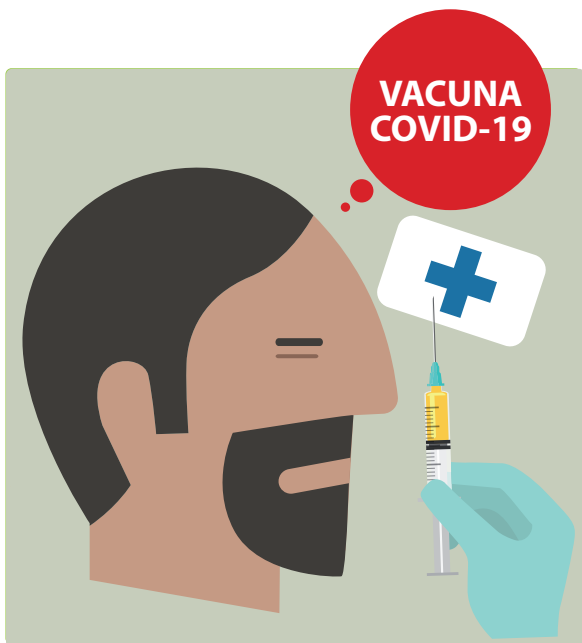


Anyone residing in Spain can be vaccinated against COVID-19, even if they have an irregular administrative status. The procedure for vaccinating such people may differ in each Spanish autonomous community. If this is your situation and you are unsure about how to be vaccinated against COVID-19, you may call your autonomous community's helpline and they will tell you what to do.

## COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR PEOPLE WITHOUT ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE

Spain's COVID-19 vaccination strategy establishes that anyone resident in the country may be vaccinated, regardless of their administrative status. The autonomous communities have implemented procedures to try and reach everyone who is not covered by the health system, either because they are not registered or because they have no health card.

The COVID-19 vaccination procedures implemented by the autonomous communities cover:

- Telephone lines for people without a health card to obtain information about vaccination.
- Vaccination at a health centre upon presentation of an ID document.
- Vaccination at a health centre upon presentation of a certificate of municipal registration.
- Vaccination at a health centre or through an intermediary NGO.
- Collaboration of NGOs in issuing the details of people they deal with so that the healthcare system can locate and vaccinate them.

If you do not have access to the healthcare system in Spain and if you have not been vaccinated against COVID-19 and wish to be so, do not hesitate to visit the health centre nearest your home or a nearby NGO for advice and assistance.

Not having health card or regular administrative status should not prevent you from being vaccinated.
